Bringing members greater cost savings and a \$0 copay for specialty drugs¹



Specialty drugs offer innovative therapies in addition to traditional medicines for a variety of health conditions — but they are complex and confusing and can be costly for members.

How Cost Relief works to save money

With Cost Relief, members can access available manufacturer copay assistance program funds through a high-touch enrollment experience. This allows us to reduce the costs of certain specialty drugs. When members enroll in this program, they may pay significantly less for their specialty medicines.

Prior to the program effective date, we reach out to eligible members through letters and phone calls to educate them about Cost Relief, including what help is available to them in their own copay assistance program. We also make sure they know how to enroll and stay enrolled in the program.

- Virtually all specialty drugs are included as part of this program.
- This program provides reporting and analytics, including use and outreach metrics.

Plan exclusions: federal employee programs (FEPs), Medicare supplement insurance, group retiree plans, no bill/no remit pharmacy, health reimbursement arrangement with provider pay, and grandfathered/grandmothered plans
